

**Students at Home  
Positive COVID-19**

- **Notify school – provide evidence of positive PCR test. If positive RAT test, [register](#) result and get PCR test**
- Await and respond to all WA Health advice
- No expectation that work is completed, as child is unwell
- At completion of quarantine / isolation period, notify school providing evidence of fitness to return to school

**Students at Home:  
Isolating but well  
*Maintenance of Learning***

On confirmation of need to isolate:

- **Notify school – provide evidence of need to isolate if close contact from outside of school setting**

**Student will:**

- Make contact daily for attendance e.g. send a message on Class Dojo to say they have completed work

**Teacher will:**

- Provide learning at home instructions and support through Class Dojo

**Class Dojo:** Ongoing – contact with class teacher during isolation period for at home learning support

**SAMPLE Letter to Parents:**

Dear Families and Students:

As you know, (ECE/ELA/MLA/SLA) have been asked to isolate. For the next XX days, I/We/Relief Teacher, will be providing some work through ClassDojo. <Name> is to use their At Home Learning workbook to complete their work in. This has been sent home today and is to remain at home for use when needed.

There is a timetable attached in the front of their At Home Learning workbook to follow daily, using the activities sent out on ClassDojo. There is no need to print any work. Students can write the answers directly into their At Home Learning workbooks.

Once they have done some or all of the work, if students/parents can send a message on Dojo to let us know, that will be appreciated. This will allow us to mark the roll to say that you have attended learning for the day. Of course, if you have any questions about the work, you can send a message on ClassDojo and we will try to answer as soon as we can.

Also if you are sick, like always, you are not expected to do the work. Can you please let the front office know via SMS, 0448 975 969 or phone 9796 7500 that you are sick.
