Term 2 Week 6 Principals Update — Rob McArdle

Kaya GHPS Families,

This week we celebrate <u>National Reconciliation Week</u> and in doing so, take up this year's theme to Be Brave. Make Change. Our challenge this National Reconciliation Week is to continue the work in striving towards a more culturally responsive and reconciled society. As a school, we seek to ensure that all students learn about the shared histories, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. We also seek to instil in all an understanding of how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia. This week, we are encouraged to Be Brave. Make Change, and take time to consider what reconciliation means to us.

COVID-19 Update

COVID-19 has continued to impact the school on a day to day basis with many staff and students sick with the virus. Due to this, classrooms have been impacted with high level of absenteeism and more relief staff than usual. With the wide-scale spread of COVID-19 since the start of term, we will be making a few adjustments to mass gathering type events to hopefully minimise its reach. Starting this week, we moved Monday Morning Meetings back to online. Staff meetings and other on-site meetings involving staff (school board, case conferences etc.) will move predominantly back to online platforms also. Whole school gatherings will also be postponed for the remainder of this term, with the view to holding class based gatherings from term 3.

We appreciate that COVID-19 continues to pose many challenges for our community, and we look forward to a time when its impact is less felt.

Student Safety

To ensure that students are safe and adequately supervised before and after school, we ask families to assist with the following:

- Students do not arrive to school before 8:10am
- Kindergarten and Pre-primary students are dropped off and collected by an adult each day

Can I please ask families to be extra cautious if parking on the verge on Edith Cowan Drive. A recent report of a near miss accident involving a student after school highlights the need for high levels of supervision with children crossing busy roads.




